



FERGUSON T20 VINTAGE PLOUGHING RULES

1. TRACTOR

Ferguson T20 and Ford Ferguson tractors. Only genuine Ferguson top links allowed.

2. PLOUGHS

- Any mounted plough produced for T20 in production **before 31st December 1959**
- Plough bodies to be designed for plough at time of manufacture.
- Skimmers and one-piece tailpieces are optional – no other attachments allowed.
- Tailpieces should not be more than 22cm long from the end of the mouldboard and 11cm wide and can only be adjusted by the mouldboard bolts.
- Plough bodies can be raised or lowered but cannot be raised out of the 'ploughing' position.
- All plough bodies to be used when ploughing the finish.
- Extraneous attachments that manipulate the furrows or scratches are not allowed.
- Weights can be used on tractors or ploughs.

3. TIME ALLOWED

- 20 minutes for opening. **Penalty for failure to finish opening on time – 2 points per minute or part minute.**
- 40 minutes for openings to be judged.
- 4 hours to complete the plot. **Penalty for failure to finish the plot at finishing signal – 10 points per minute or part minute**
- 15 minutes for any cast-off made after commencement of ploughing.
- Maximum of one hour only allowed for a breakdown.

4. OPENING

- Double opening – no land left unturned.
- On grassland there is no opening.

5. START

- The start shall consist of 11 or 12 furrows.
- Competitors must cast towards the next highest numbered plot.

6. FINISH

- The finish shall consist of the last 8 furrows.
- Last furrow to be cast towards competitors' own start.

7. DEPTH

Depth to be reached on completion of start and adhered to until commencing the finish.
Minimum depth 15 cm.

8. GENERAL

- The first run next to the neighbouring competitor will not be judged, but ploughmen must not mark their neighbours' ploughing with their tractor wheel. If there is a problem, the competitor must contact the head steward for a ruling before ploughing the first run next to their neighbour.
- Rolling of furrows or scratches is **not** allowed. **Penalty – 20 points deduction.**
- Twin tractor wheels **not** allowed.
- Three sighting poles only (one can be placed on the headland) – assistance to set and remove is allowed. No other assistance allowed including no assistance by signal, radio contact, mobile phone or any other method.
- Handling, shaping or treading of scratches or furrows is **not** allowed.
- Only one tractor and plough wheel mark allowed at the finish.

- Only the competitor allowed the clean the plot of straw, stones, etc
- Competitors must produce evidence of age of tractor if requested.
- The use of Global Positioning Technology, laser beams or any other electronic or computerised measuring devices are not allowed.
- Any abuse or dispute by a competitor with an official or fellow competitor is not acceptable. **Penalty – 20 points.**

9. SAFETY

- Passengers not allowed on tractors or ploughs at any time.
- Society of Ploughmen Safety Policy to be adhered to at all times.

10. FINAL DECISION

Any question arising and not provided for these rules shall be decided by the Executive Committee whose decision shall be final and binding.

JUDGES METHOD OF SCORING – VINTAGE PLOUGHS

OPENING	20
<i>Well cut, uniform and straight</i>	
START (11 or 12 furrows)	20
<i>Uniform, level and straightness</i>	
SEED BED	20
<i>Weed control and soil made available</i>	
FIRMNESS	20
<i>Firm, well packed furrows, no holes</i>	
UNIFORMITY	20
<i>Clearly defined uniform furrows, straightness and no pairing of furrows</i>	
FINISH	20
<i>Uniform, shallow and straightness</i>	
INS AND OUTS	20
<i>Neat, accurate and regular</i>	
GENERAL APPEARANCE	20
<i>Workmanship and general appearance of the whole plot</i>	

FIXED PENALTY DEDUCTIONS

Two tractor wheel marks	20 points penalty
Finish wrong way	20 points penalty
Depth infringement	20 points per cm less than specified depth
Rolling	20 points penalty
Failure to finish opening on time	2 points per min or part min over time
Failure to finish plot by finishing signal	10 points per min or part min over time
Abuse of officials or fellow competitors	20 points penalty
Failure to adhere to the Safety Policy	Disqualification

Any other penalty deduction will be decided by the Executive Committee
